DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Glenn Schlosnagle Tenant House is located on the W side of Brethern Church Road, about a quarter mile SE of Accident. The house is surrounded by trees.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed dwelling built on a T-plan. The T projects from the facade, which points E. A one story, hipped roof porch fills the T on both sides and covers the E end of the T as well. A one-story, shed-roofed porch covers the W elevation.

The house rests on a cut stone foundation and is covered with green German siding. The windows are one over one sash with drip mouldings and plain board surrounds. The facade has two doors on the E elevation of the main block, on either side of the T.

The roof is covered with slate shingles. The house has one interior brick stove chimney on the S side of the T. The facade porch roof is covered with asphalt shingles and is supported by wooden Roman Doric columns. The porch on the W elevation has been enclosed at its S end to form a storage room. The rest of the porch roof is supported by square posts and a plain square balustrade.

The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.

NW of the house is a one-story, gable-roofed out building covered with German siding. The site also includes a modern frame barn.
