## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Maust-Georg House is located off Brethern Church Road, approximately .2 miles E on a dirt driveway. The site is wooded and surrounded by rolling hills.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points W. The ground falls from W to E, revealing a full basement story on the E elevation. Both the facade and the E elevation are covered on the first floor by shed-roofed porches.

The house rests on a cut stone foundation and is covered with german siding. The windows are two over two sash with drip mouldings and symmetrically moulded surrounds. All doors have transoms. The roof is covered with square and fishscale slate shingles.

The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, one at each gable end. There is also an exterior cinder-block stove chimney on the N gable end. The porch roofs are covered with corrugated metal and are supported by square posts. The porch posts on the E elevation feature jigsaw brackets.

The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.
