DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Harold Kahl House is located on the south side of Bumblebee Road, about 3/4 mile E of Rt 219S. The house is backed by trees and beyond are rolling hills.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan dwelling with a gable end facade pointing NE. The ell extends from the SE elevation. The first floor of the facade and the ell are filled with an enclosed, hipped-roofed porch. A one-story, gable-roofed addition extends from the SE elevation.

The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles. Under the asbestos is asphalt roll siding covering weather-boarding. The windows are one over one sash with plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with corrugated metal.

The house has one interior brick stove chimney at the ridge line of the ell. The porch and addition have modern sash and sliding windows, and their roofs are covered with asphalt shingles.

To the east of the house is a frame bank barn. The bank entrance points northeast.
