DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Moon-Smith House is located in a small valley on the east side of Bumblebee Road, about a mile NE of Deep Creek Lake. The site is somewhat overgrown and has a good view of farmlands to the northeast.

The house is a two-story, pyramid-roofed dwelling constructed on a square plan. The three-bay, center-door facade points south and has an additional door cut into the westernmost bay.

The house rests on a cut coursed stone foundation and the stud walls are covered with German siding laid over diagonally-placed boards. The windows are 1/1 with plain board surrounds. On the facade, the first floor windows have narrow upper sashes of many small leaded lights and large single-pane lower sashes. The central facade door has a transom.

The roof has two hipped-roofed dormers, one on the east and one on the west elevation. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, placed east and west of center.

The house has a scar stretching across all four elevations between the first and second floors. On the west, south, and east elevations, this marks the former location of the roof of a one-story porch. On the north elevation, half the elevation was covered by the porch, half by a one-story pantry.

The interior displays a four-room, center stair plan. All interior finishes have been removed. Two interior doors retain transoms.

The house is unoccupied and is in the process of renovation.
