DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Marlin Savage House is located W off Rt. 219S, at the intersection of Spear Road. The house is placed in a hollow and to the NW a farm road runs back to a small cemetery.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points SE and is covered with a one-story, hipped-roofed sunporch. The NW elevation has a similar sun porch.

The house rests on a coursed stone foundation and the plank-constructed walls are covered with aluminum siding. The house has two over two and one over one sash windows. All surrounds have been obscured. The roof is covered on the SE elevation with asphalt shingles and on the NW elevation with tar paper.

The house has two stove chimneys: a central brick chimney and an exterior cinderblock chimney on the SW gable end. The facade porch is enclosed with modern windows. The interior arrangement is unknown.

About .1 mile to the NW is a small cemetery, containing about twenty graves. The oldest grave is that of Singleton Sutter, who died in 1857 at the age of 26. His gravestone is signed "J.S. Cumb'd."

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is an example of a common western Maryland type. Houses of this general configuration, a rectangular main block measuring three bays across the facade, were constructed in Garrett County from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries.
