**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Richard D. Fike House is located on the south side of Rt. 219S, approximately a mile NE of Hoyes Road. The house stands in a level field and west of the house is a line of pine trees.

The house is a one and a half story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points north and is covered by a shed-roofed porch. On the south elevation the east end is covered by a shed-roofed porch.

The house rests on a low stone foundation and is covered on the W, S, and E. elevations by asbestos shingles. The facade (N. elevation) is covered by German siding. The windows are one over one sash with plain board surrounds. The facade door has a single glass panel set into its upper half.

The roof is covered with corrugated metal and the rafter ends are exposed. The facade porch roof is supported by square posts.

The interior arrangement is unknown.
