## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Hoyes Store is located on the NE corner of the intersection of Hoyes Road and Hoyes-Sang Run Road. The store sits at the edge of the road and consists of a combination store and dwelling.

The store is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan structure with two facades. The original facade, on the S elevation, has three bays and a central door, while the modern gable-end facade is on the W elevation and has two bays. A one-story, shed-roofed porch covers the W facade, S facade, and E elevation. An enclosed shed porch fills the ell on the W facade.

The store rests on a low stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles. The windows are two over two sash, with drip mouldings and plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with diamond-shaped asphalt shingles.

The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, one at the center of the main block and one at the center of the ell. The porch roof is covered with asphalt shingles and is supported by square posts.

The interior of the store divides the first floor of the main block into two rooms: a display area, and a kitchen.

Directly W of the store, across Hoyes-Sang Run Road, is a one-story, gable-roofed warehouse. It is covered with German siding and is no longer used. S of the warehouse is a small old-fashioned pump.

Area residents say there has been a store in this building since the 19th century. As the only store in the area, the Hoyes Store also became the center of mail-order activity, and the warehouse was used to store machinery or large quantities of grains until they were called for.
