DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Wade and Edna Bernard Farmhouse is a two-and-a-half story, three by three bay frame house with a gable roof and an ell projecting from the southwest side (added in the Late 30's). On the southeast facade and northeast side of the structure runs a porch with enclosures at both ends. On the third or half story of the house are single windows in the gable ends. The windows in the house are double hung sash with one over one lights. The cellar of the house can be entered from a slightly below ground level entrance on the southeast. In this cellar a spring is pumped through for the refrigeration of milk, butter and cream. The house has two brick chimneys, both centrally located, one on the main structure and one in the ell. The house is presently covered with asbestos shingles, but German siding lies underneath.

Numerous outbuildings are located on the farm including a barn built in 1903 by Peter Lohr, smoke house, coal house, chicken house, etc.


