The house stands on high ground and overlooks the lake and the Deep Creek Lake Bridge, G-III-B-028.

George Storm who owned the house in 1924, used it as a boardinghouse for area coal miners and for the workers engaged in constructing the Deep Creek Dam and Powerhouse.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Grace King House is located on the S side of Rt. 219S at Deep Creek Lake. The house stands on high ground and overlooks the lake and the Deep Creek Lake Bridge, G-III-B-028.

The house is a one and a half story, gambrel-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points NE and the house rests on a high foundation, making a full basement story on the facade. Shed-roofed porches cover both the NE and SW elevations.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation which has been faced with rock-faced concrete block on the facade. The walls are covered with asbestos shingles and the windows are one over one sash with plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and the rafter ends are exposed. The NE and SW elevations each have three gable-roofed dormers.

The house has one interior brick stove chimney, set NW of center at ridgeline. The porch roofs are covered with asphalt shingles and are supported by turned posts. The interior arrangement of the house is unknown


