DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Arch Beckman House is located on the E side of Beckman Peninsula Road, about a tenth of a mile S of Glendale Road. The site includes a frame barn and the house is surrounded by a meadow.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points S and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed porch which also covers the E elevation and fills the T on that side.

The house rests on a cut coursed stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles over German siding. The windows are two over two sash with plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and has exposed rafter ends. Each gable end has shallowly carved, narrow barge boards.

The house has one exterior cinderblock stove chimney on the W gable end. The porch roof is covered with asphalt shingles and on the facade is supported by square posts; on the E elevation and in the T the porch has been enclosed.

The interior consists of three rooms arranged around a central stairhall. The staircase has turned balusters and a carved newel post topped with a ball finial. All interior doorways have symmetrically moulded surrounds and bullseye corner blocks.

SE of the house is a frame, gable-roofed barn on a stone foundation.


