DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Rudolph Beckman House is located on the W side of Beckman Peninsula Road, about a quarter mile S of Glendale Road. The house is surrounded by trees.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed dwelling with an irregular plan. The gable-end facade points S and is covered by a one-story, shed-roofed, enclosed sun porch which also covers the southern half of the E elevation.

The house rests on a coursed stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles laid over German siding. The windows are two two sash with plain board surrounds. The facade door is set into the westernmost bay.

The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. The house has one interior brick stove chimney near the W gable end. The facade sun porch is set with four over four sash windows.


