The Adam Colmers farmhouse is a two-and-a-half story three bay by one bay German sided, stud constructed frame structure with a cross gable roof and central rear ell. This ell has a porch on both its sides. The one on the south side is enclosed.

The windows on the structure are double hung sash with two over two lights. On the northeast facade is a small entrance deck. There is still visual evidence of a porch that once was there.

The front entrance includes a transom and a decoratively carved door with an upper glass panel (like the one at Site #G-III-C-141). In the gable ends are square windows.


