On the front of the structure, and to the northwest side of the ell, is a porch supported by turned posts with balustrades and decorative trim.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Lena Pritts house is situated on the edge of Dry Run Road and faces a northwesterly direction. It is a two story frame weather board structure with a three by two bay main structure with a two bay ell extending on the front southwest side. The structure has a gable roof from which protrudes a central brick chimney.

On the front of the structure, and to the northwest side of the ell, is a porch supported by turned posts with balustrades and decorative trim. On either side of the ell is an additional entrance. Another addition; a shed, single story type, appears along one back southeast facade. The weatherboard structure sits on a stone foundation partially covered with concrete. The roof is covered with sheet metal. Other outbuildings appear on the property also; including a root cellar and frame sheds.


