The C. E. Ellithorpe Store is a two story, three-bay by four-bay gable roof structure with the bracketed gable end front. A one-bay by three-bay wing extends from the center of the north elevation.

Asbestos shingles cover the walls of the house.

A two story frame building, located across Rt. 495 to the east, was built in the early 20th century to serve as a storage facility for the store. A small frame kitchen stands about 20 feet northwest of the main house.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is located in a hilly, semi-wooded area on Rt. 495. The house faces east. It is a two story, three-bay by four-bay gable roof structure with the bracketed gable end front. A one-bay by three-bay wing extends from the center of the north elevation. A single story shed addition is located off the west elevation of the wing, running into a similar addition off the north elevation of the main block.

A wooden porch, supported by plain posts, covers the facade of the main block. A wooden porch, supported by round columns, covers the facade of the wing.

An entrance is located on the center of the facade of the main block, the center facade of the wing, and the west elevation of the shed addition off the main block.

A central brick chimney is located on the wing. An exterior brick chimney is located at the south elevation. 2/2 sash windows light the house.

Asbestos shingles cover the walls of the house, with asphalt shingles on the roof.

A two story frame building, located across Rt. 495 to the east, was built in the early 20th century to serve as a storage facility for the store. A small frame kitchen stands about 20 feet northwest of the main house.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is an example of a common Western Maryland type. Houses of this general configuration, a rectangular main block and side ell, were constructed in Garrett County from the late 19th through the early 20th centuries.

The main block of this structure was originally a store, the ell was the main house.


