DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area on Frank Brenneman Road approximately one mile south of Maynardier Ridge Road. The house faces south.

It is a two story, three-bay by two-bay gable roof structure with a two-bay deep ell.

A porch, supported by chamfered wooden posts, extends the length of the facade. A similar porch is located along the rear, north, elevation of the main block to the ell. The house is entered from the central facade entrance.

An exterior brick chimney is located at the west elevation where the ell meets the main block. 2/2 sash windows, framed with plain flat boards, light the house. Two-pane windows are located in the gable ends. A double window is located on the first story of the west elevation of the ell.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation. Asphalt sheeting covers the house. Seamed metal covers the roof.


