Another field view on October 25, 1998 by KCI indicated the former asphalt shingle porch roof on the west and south elevations of the building was being replaced with standing seam metal roof. A photograph documenting this change accompanies this Addendum.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

201 'I' Street, Mountain Lake Park, has a plan very similar to that of the Chautauqua Cottage [G-24], also in Mountain Lake Park. The plan is cruciform and both houses are 2 storey clapboard dwellings with abruptly pointed Gothic windows and a porch on the front. Here, however, the porch continues around to include the side wings, rather than just reaching to them. The most notable difference in this house is its square tower placed at the junction of two wings. The orientation of the house is set at this corner tower and the main entrance is here, with porch steps also placed here. A stage taller than the rest of the building, the tower has a small diamond shaped window on each side; each side of the tower is peaked, thus forming a tower roof of two intersecting gable roofs which echoes (parallels) the main roof of the house.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

201 'I' Street is a more elaborate example of the cottage style dwelling described as the Chautauqua Cottage [G-24], its excellent condition making this one of the best preserved examples of the modified Italianate Cottage-Villa that blossomed in Mountain Lake Park with the resort's popularity. Like other cottages in the vicinity, this only reinforces the association of the cottage-style with vacation building.

[201 is opposite the Clayton Cottage, G-31.]



