The Hutton Post Office House faces southwest towards the B&O Railroad tracks, just west of Hutton Road in the village of Hutton. The three-bay-wide, one-bay-deep, 2-story frame house has a 1-story rear wing with enclosed porches on either side.

The first floor of the front facade has a central door flanked by pairs of 2/2 sash windows. The door and pairs of windows are covered by molded cornices with tiny dentils, and have chamfered pilasters on the sides. The front porch has iron posts and chamfered pilasters against the house. No steps currently lead up to the porch, which rests on a concrete block foundation. The ends of this porch foundation have one 2-pane window each. The front of the porch foundation has one 2-pane window and a cellar door on the far left end. The second floor of the front facade contains three 2/2 sash windows, with the same dentiled cornice and pilasters as those on the first floor.

The northwest gable end of the house has one 2/2 sash window on each floor, with the same treatments as those on the front of the house. A single exterior concrete block chimney stack rises to the right of the windows.

The southeast gable end is the same as the northwest, but without the chimney stack.

Another concrete chimney stack rises within the northeast corner of the house. The enclosed porch in this corner of the house contains a pair of 2/2 sash windows with the aforementioned treatments.

On the property is a small two-bay-wide, one-bay-deep shed-roofed frame structure with exposed rafter feet. This small building, presumably the old Hutton Post Office, faces northwest, with the roof sloping towards the back. The front facade has a paneled door in the right bay, and a 6/6 sash window in the left bay. The southwest end of the building, at least, also has a 6/6 sash window.

The building appears to be used now for storage.
