This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly, wooded area off Herrington Manor Road approximately ¼ mile south of the turn off to Herrington Manor Park. The house faces northeast. It is a two story three bay by one bay structure with a gable roof. The house is entered by a central entrance on the facade.

The house has two interior brick end chimneys: one at both the north-west and southeast elevations. Windows are predominately two over two sash. The house is covered with asphalt shingles. Tarpaper covers the roof.


