Based on information provided by SHA, Bridge No. 11056 does not appear to meet NR criteria for individual listing nor is it located in any known historic district. The simple concrete slab bridge was constructed in the 1920s to standard plans. It is a very common type and has no historical or engineering significance. In addition, it is severely deteriorated and has been closed to traffic for a number of years. The bridge is located outside the Mountain Lake Park Historic District and does not appear to be located in any other historic district.


