The single-family dwelling at 258 Keefer Road in Oakland, Garrett County, MD is not located in an historic district, nor is it considered individually eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The one-story frame dwelling was built ca. 1940 and has been added onto and altered in a make-shift manner since then. The house sits upon a rubble stone foundation and is covered with a wide gable roof. The dwelling lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for listing under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


