The Bucklew House, located at 29 Stanley Lane in Crellin, Garrett County, MD is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The house is located outside of the Crellin Historic District and appears to date to the first quarter of the 20th century. It is two-story, two-bay frame house with a two-story rear ell. A shed roof porch extends across the front elevation and shed roof additions are found on the side and rear elevations. The house is typical of the rural domestic building of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or C.


