The dwelling at 175 West Ashby-Ellis Road in Oakland, Maryland is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The dwelling is a late 19th-century-early 20th century two-story, two-bay frame building with 20th-century rear wing additions. It sits upon a low foundation, is covered with a gable roof with asphalt shingles and has walls clad with asbestos or aluminum siding. A one-story, gable-roof wing projects from the rear elevation of the house. The dwelling is typical of the late 19th-century-early 20th century, rural domestic building of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness or integrity to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and does not qualify for listing under Criteria A or B.




