The single-family residence at 1056 Crellin Mine Rd. in Oakland, Garrett County, Maryland is not located in an historic district and is not individually eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

Built in the first quarter of this century, the dwelling is a two-story, three-bay frame structure. It sits upon a low concrete slab (?) foundation and is covered with a gable roof. The walls are clad with replacement siding. The building is representative of early 20th-century rural vernacular building and follows a common dwelling form. The house lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and thus does not qualify for listing under criteria A or B.


