DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Herman Steiding Farm is located on the N side of Steiding Church Road, about a mile E of Turkey Neck Road. The site consists of a house and a barn.

The house is a two-story, pyramid-roofed, square-plan house with an asymmetrical four-bay facade. The facade points S and is covered by a one-story, shed-roofed porch.

The house rests on a high, poured concrete foundation and is covered with German siding. The windows are one over one sash with drip moldings and plain board surrounds. The facade doors are placed in the two central bays.

The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and has a wide soffit. The house has one interior concrete block stove chimney on the E side of the house. The facade porch has square posts and a balustrade of square posts. Above the porch roof on the facade are the shadows of a second floor porch. The interior arrangement of the house was not investigated.

NE of the house is a frame, gable-roofed bank barn. The bank entrance points N and a brick silo is attached to the SE corner.


