**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Josephus Harvey House is located on the S side of Paradise Point Road, just E of its intersection with Sand Flat Road. The house is backed by fields.

The house is a two-story, pyramid-roofed, square-plan frame house with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points NW and it and the NE elevation are covered with a one-story, shed-roofed porch. A one-story, shed-roofed addition extends from the center of the SE elevation.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation and is covered with molded-bebel novelty siding. The windows are one over one sash with drip moldings and symmetrically molded surrounds. The roof is covered with slate and has two cross gables, one on the NW and one on the SW elevation.

The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, one on the SW and one on the SE elevation. The porch roof is covered with asphalt shingles and supported by square posts. The interior arrangement of the house was not investigated.


