DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Henry Friend House is located N off Pysell Crosscut Road, about half a mile E of Sand Flat Road.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points NW and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed porch. The T is filled on the NE elevation by a one-story, hipped-roofed addition.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation and is covered with white weatherboarding. The windows are one over one and two over two sash with drip moldings and plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles.

The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, one at the center of the main block and one at the SE gable end. The facade porch has square columns on concrete bases. The interior arrangements of the house was not investigated.
