DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Old Scott Paugh House is located on the N side of Paradise Point Road, about a mile and a quarter NE of Sand Flat Road. The house is set well back among trees and the property is very overgrown.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points SE and is covered by a one-story, hipped-roofed porch. Both sides of the T are partially filled with porches, a storm porch on the SW and an open porch on the NE. The NW bay of the T appears to be an addition, evidenced by a break in the siding covered with a batten.

The house rests on a cut stone foundation and is covered with weatherboarding. The windows are two over two sash with drip moldings and plain board surrounds. The facade door has a single-pane transom.

The roof is covered with standing seam metal. The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, one to the SW of center on the main block, and one at the center of the T. The facade porch roof is covered with tar paper and is supported by chamfered posts. The open porch on the NE elevation has a tar paper roof which is supported by turned posts. The storm porch on the SW is covered with German siding. The interior arrangement of the house was not investigated.

W of the house is a small board and batten springhouse, while S of the house is a gable-roofed frame storage building.

This house is an example of a common western Maryland type. Houses of this general configuration, a rectangular main block and rear kitchen wing, were constructed in Garrett County from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries. This house was constructed by the father of the builder of the house and barn at G-IV-B-079.


