The Schenk House, located at 4151 Sandflat Road in Oakland, Garrett County, MD is not located in an historic district, nor is it eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The house is a ca. 1900 two-story, three-bay, frame farmhouse with a two-story ell. It is set upon a concrete foundation (underpinned or covering historic foundation) and is covered with a cross gable roof. The windows are the original 2/2 sash. The walls are clad with aluminum, put in place in the 1970s. The house is typical of the rural domestic architecture of the period lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity to qualify for listing on the Register under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.




