**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Harvey Brothers Farm is located on the west side of Paradise Acres Road, on the Paradise Point, about a mile southwest of Deep Creek Lake. The farm consists of a house, barn and small garage.

The House is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan dwelling with an irregular facade. The facade is composed of the east gable end of the main block and the east elevation of the ell, and measures five bays across. The first floor is covered with an enclosed, hipped-roofed sun porch. An enclosed, she-roofed, one-story porch fills the ell on the west and south elevations and a one-story, hipped-roof addition and porch covers the west gable end.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation and is covered with wood shingles. The windows are one over one and two over two sash, with drip mouldings and plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles.

The house has two stove chimneys: an exterior cinderblock on the south gable end and an interior brick chimney at the center of the main block.

The facade porch has a central door and its roof is covered with tar paper.

The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.

Northwest of the house is a frame, gambrel-roofed barn. North of the barn is a small frame garage.
