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**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Joe Holtschneider Farm is located on the N. side of Spring Glade Road, about a mile and three-quarters west of Sand Flat Road. The farm consists of a house and several outbuildings.

The house is a 2-story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points west and is covered by a shed-roofed, one-story porch. Attached to the north gable end is a one-story, gable roofed addition. The house is built of vertical planks.

The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered by asphalt siding over weatherboarding. The windows are two over two sash and have plain board surrounds. The roof is covered with tar paper.

The house has two interior brick stove chimneys, one at the center of the house and one at the north gable end. The facade porch roof is covered with tar paper and is supported by turned posts. The interior arrangement of the house is unknown. N.E. of the house is a small stone and frame springhouse with a gable roof. Several frame outbuildings. N.W. of the house are two more outbuildings and the ruins of a barn.


