STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The configuration of this schoolhouse is similar to many others scattered about Garrett County, but is one of the newer examples, having been first opened for use on September 30, 1907. The trustees at this time were Fred Holtschneider, Allan deBerry, and William deBerry. The first teacher, Miss Lillie Weimer, walked three miles from her home at Mountain Lake Park every day to teach. The school closed in 1934 or 1935, after which it was deeded back to the original landowner, who renovated it for a private dwelling.


