DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Ralph Calendrella House is located on a dirt road about a half mile north of Upperman Road. The house sits in an overgrown field. The site includes a log springhouse.

The house is a 1½ story, gable-roofed log dwelling. The facade faces north. The rectangular building measures a single bay in each dimension. A collapsing shed-roofed section covers the south side. A porch, now gone, once protected the facade.

Entrances appear on each side except the west, which is lit by a 6/6 window. A single 6-pane window lights the north side of the loft. The facade door opening, which was originally located directly beneath the loft window, has been enlarged to the east to accommodate double barn doors. The western door jam is original. Plain flat boards frame the openings.

The floor plan comprises a single room on either floor. A boxed stair turns in the northwest corner.




