The William Sharpless House is a frame, two story, gable-roofed building on a coursed, roughly squared stone foundation. Its basic configuration is a T-plan with both facade and rear porches. The rear wing is a later addition. The facade is composed of three bays of symmetrically placed windows with a door between the two bays at the southern end. The facade porch, which covers the southern half of the facade, is a recent construction. A scar on the building indicates the past presence of a full length porch. The house rests on hewn sills and is constructed of vertical planks with horizontal bracing. Whitewashed weatherboard with cornerboards covers the framing. An interior stone chimney is located on the ridgeline of the main block which leads to a large stone fireplace inside. This fireplace has been blocked and covered over in recent years, however.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The William Sharpless House is located on the west side of Mt. Zion Road approximately .1 mile south of Maryland Route 135 down a lane .3 mile from the road. The facade of the building points southwest.

The house is a frame, two story, gable-roofed building on a coursed, roughly squared stone foundation. Its basic configuration is a T-plan with both facade and rear porches. The rear wing is a later addition. The facade is composed of three bays of symmetrically placed windows with a door between the two bays at the southern end. The facade porch, which covers the southern half of the facade, is a recent construction. A scar on the building indicates the past presense of a full length porch.

The house rests on hewn sills and is constructed of vertical planks with horizontal bracing. Whitewashed weatherboard with cornerboards covers the framing.

The first floor windows of the main block have been replaced with one over one aluminum sash. Its second floor is lit by six over three sash, and the rear wing retains it two over two windows.

The roof is covered with asphalt, has a box cornice on the main block and boxed rafter ends on the rear addition. An interior stone chimney is located on the ridgline of the main block which leads to a large stone fireplace inside. This fireplace has been blocked and covered over in recent years, however. There is also an exterior cinderblock flue on the southeast side of the rear addition.

Cement block and stone footings support a shed porch on the northwest side of the rear wing. A porch on the southwest side of the wing has been removed.




