DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Lighthouse Bible Church is located just west of Redhouse and is typical of rural churches built at the turn of the century.

It is a gable roofed, frame, four bay long by one bay wide structure with a wider, three bay by one bay addition on the facade, south elevation. The facade has a central, in-set entrance. A one-story shed addition at the southwest corner of the facade addition and rear section covers an entrance to the basement.

The church rests on a concrete block and stone, covered with scoured concrete, foundation. The walls of the facade addition are covered with german siding; the rear section with weatherboard siding. The facade addition gable roof is covered with standing seam metal; the rear section with corrugated metal.

The facade entrance has double, wooden, doors with an ornate machine-made door handle (manufactured by Dexter).

Windows are 6/6 sash with plain board surrounds and drip-molded window heads. A 12 pane window is located above the entrance. An interior cement-block chimney is located at the west end of the facade addition.

A date stone survives; (it has been covered with concrete) and is located at the west corner of the facade. It reads: "Apr. 6 1895."




Table Rock; MD-WV
