DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated on Route 219 approximately .4 miles northeast of Redhouse. The house faces southeast. It is a two story three bay by two bay gable roof structure with a two story one bay by one bay ell. A plain wooden porch extends across the facade and the northeast elevation of the main block. A porch is also located on the northeast elevation of the ell. An entrance is located on the center of the facade and at the porch off the ell on the northeast elevation.

The house has a central brick chimney and an interior brick end chimney, both located on the main structure. The ell has an interior gable end brick chimney. Two over two sash windows light the house. Small arched windows are located in the gables of the main block. The house rests on a coursed stone with mortar foundation. The house is covered with asbestos shingle siding with the exception of the northeast elevation and 1st story facade of the main block, where the original narrow weatherboard siding and cornerboards are exposed. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles.

There are 2 frame outbuildings and a frame barn associated with this site.




Table Rock: MD;WV
