Asbestos shingles obscure the original siding.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Willard P. Delsignore House is located on the west side of Tablerock Road approximately 2.1 miles south of U.S. Route 50. It is situated on a dirt lane .4 mile from the road with its facade pointing northeast.

The house is a frame, two story, gable-roofed building. Its basic configuration is a three bay by two bay main block with a two bay by one bay rear ell. A shed-roofed porch with chamfered posts extends across the facade, continues around the southeast endwall to the rear, and southeast side of the ell. The facade has a three bay, center door arrangement with an unfenestrated second floor center bay.

Two over two sash windows with plain board surrounds light the building on all elevations. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles, has boxed rafter ends and a plain board frieze on the gable ends. An interior brick chimney is located on the southeast endwall and another is located on the northwest side of the ridgeline on the rear ell. Asbestos shingles cover the exterior walls.

The interior of this building was not accessible.
