DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area off Paul Friend Road, approximately one mile southeast of Route 219. The house faces northeast. It is a two story, three bay by two bay gable roof structure with brackets and a gable end facade. The house has an ell two bays deep with a single story shed addition that extends across its southeast elevation. A single story extending bay is located on the southeast elevation of the main block. A porch, supported by wooden turned and knobbed posts with jig-sawn trim runs across the facade to a single story gable roof modern addition which extends outward. Entrances appear on the central front, at the rear shed addition and two on the modern facade addition.

The house has a central brick chimney. One over one sash windows light the house. Diamond-shaped windows are located in the gables of the main block. Plain flat boards frame the windows. The house rests on a stone foundation. Weatherboard siding covers the house with the exceptions of aluminum siding on the modern addition and the northwest elevation of the main block. Asphalt shingles cover the roof. A cellar entrance is located at the northwest elevation.

A bank barn and other outbuildings are located on the property as well.




Table Rock, MD:WV
