## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Corunna School is located northwest of Bayard WV in a hilly area.

It follows the basic plan of Garrett County one-room schoolhouses, a one-story frame structure measuring one bay by three bays. The school rests on a concrete foundation, has weatherboard siding with cornerboards and a gable roof covered with tarpaper.

The central entrance is on the NE gable end. The facade is covered by a shed addition supported by three foot high concrete piers. There is an entrance to the shed addition on the NW elevation.

The windows are 4/4 sash, as seen on the SE elevation. Two of the windows on the NW elevation are boarded up; the center one is open.

A central brick chimney extends partially into the interior and is enclosed by a wooden flue box with a circular opening for the stove flue box on the SW side.

The interior of the school is one room with wood floors and narrow beaded board walls and ceiling.

The walls have narrow, vertical beaded boards below a molded chair rail (approximately 3' high) and narrow horizontal beaded boards above the chair rail to the ceiling.

The interior of the shed addition is treated with narrow horizontal beaded boards.

All windows and the central entrance have molded surrounds with bulls-eye corner boards.

There is a small concrete platform just NE of the school on the east side of Wilson-Corona Road.




Table Rock, MD:WV
