DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated among hemlocks in a hilly area on Mansfield Road, approximately p mile northwest of Rt. 219. The house faces southwest. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a gable end facade intersecting a two story one bay by two bay wing. A cinderblock shed addition is located along the southeast elevation of the wing. A wooden porch supported by turned posts runs the length of the facade. The facade entrance is located at the south end. Entrances area also located at the rear, northeast elevation of both shed additions.

A central brick chimney is located on the wing. One over one sash windows framed in narrow flat boards, light the house. Single pane windows are located in the gable ends of the main block. The house rests on a stone foundation. The house is covered in aluminum siding, framed with cornerboards, except at the southeast elevation of the wind where the original narrow weatherboard siding has been left exposed. Corrugated metal covers the roof.

A barn and springhouse are also located on the property.




Table Rock; MD:WV
