DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated in a hilly area on Underwood Road, approximately 1/8 miles east of Crellin Underwood Road. The house faces southeast. It is a two story, three bay by three bay structure with a hip roof with a gable dormer at each elevation. A wooden porch supported by slightly tapered round columns runs across the facade and the northeast elevation of the house. The house is entered from the facade entrance, with transom, and from the southwest elevation.

The house has two central brick chimneys, one at the southwest and the other at the northeast elevation of the roof, at its flat top. An exterior cinderblock chimney is located at the southwest elevation. One over one sash windows light the house. A square bay is located at the north end of the first story of the northeast elevation. The house rests on a square stone foundation. "Brick" asphalt siding covers the original weatherboard exterior. Asphalt shingles cover the roof.

A springhouse resting on a stone foundation is located northeast of the house and a small shed is located to the southwest.

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
