The Daniel W. Dodge farmhouse #1 is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a two bay by one bay ell. The house rests on a poured concrete foundation. Narrow weatherboard siding covers the exterior of the house.

The Daniel Dodge farmhouse #2 is a two story, two bay by two bay cross gable roof structure with a gable end front and extending bay ell at the northwest elevation. Vinyl siding covers the house.

A barn, built in 1896, resting on a stone foundation is located southwest of the house (#2). A verticle plank, three bay by one bay springhouse is located northeast of the smaller house (#1).

The larger house (no. 2) was built by farmer Daniel W. Dodge in 1912, the barn he built in 1896. The smaller house was there when Dodge bought the property.

**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

House #1 This frame farmhouse is situated among pine trees in a hilly area off Rt. 219 approximately 1.5 miles southwest of the town of Gortner. The house faces northwest. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a two bay by one bay ell. A wooden porch supported by slightly tapered square posts runs the length of the facade. A smaller wooden porch is located at the northeast elevation of the main block. The house is entered from the central facade entrance and from an entrance at the northeast porch.

An exterior cinderblock is located at the rear, southeast, elevation of the ell. Two over two sash windows light the house. The house rests on a poured concrete foundation. Narrow weatherboard siding covers the exterior of the house framed with corner boards. Asphalt shingles cover the roof.

House #2 This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area northwest of the smaller house on the property, house #1. This house faces southwest. It is a two story, two bay by two bay cross gable roof structure with a gable end front and extending bay ell at the northwest elevation. A single story shed addition is located at the east end of the northeast elevation and along the east end of the southeast elevation. A wooden porch supported by slightly tapered round columns extends from the ell on the northwest elevation is rounded around to cover the facade and continues around along one southeast elevation to the shed addition. Entrances are located at the southend of the facade and at the southeast elevation.

The house has a central brick chimney. One over one sash windows light the house. Small single pane windows are located in the gable ends. Vinyl siding covers the house with asphalt shingles on the roof.

A barn, built in 1896, resting on a stone foundation is located southwest of the house #2. A verticle plank, three bay by one bay springhouse is located northeast of the smaller house #1.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is an example of a common western Maryland type. Houses of this general configuration, a rectangular main block and rear kitchen wing, were constructed in Garrett County from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries.

The larger house (#2) was built by farmer Daniel W. Dodge in 1912, the barn he built in 1896. The smaller house was there when Dodge bought the property.




Table Rock: MD;WV
