DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated in a hilly area 3/4 miles off U.S. Rt. 50 approximately another 1 3/4 miles southwest of Gormanian. The house faces north. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a one bay by one bay ell. A single story shed addition is located off the east elevation of the ell. The house can be entered from the addition and from the central facade entrance.

An interior brick gable end chimney is located at the east elevation. A second exterior brick chimney is located at the rear south elevation at the point where the ell and the shed addition meet. One over one sash windows light the house. The cellar is entered from the west elevation of the main structure. The house rests on a poured concrete foundation. The original circular sawn board and batten siding has been covered with "brick" asphalt siding. Tar paper covers the roof.

A coal house and springhouse are located to the east of the house. Several recently constructed outbuildings are located to the north.


