Late 19th century

On the southeast side of Lemoyne King Road stands the James Chisholm house. Three bays wide and two stories high, the large frame house has a two-story rear wing. The front facade has on both stories a central door flanked by 1/1 sash windows. The shed-roofed first story porch is only a bit wider than the center bay, and is supported by turned posts. Above this is a smaller balcony accessed by the second floor center door. It is also supported by turned posts, and has a hip roof, dormer style, and an enclosed balustrade covered with asbestos shingles. A stove chimney rises from the approximate center of the roof. The main block of the building is one bay wide, with 1/1 sash windows and a small attic vent, and return cornices. The rear wing is attached to one side of the main block, actually projecting beyond it. This wing is two bays long and one bay wide, with a shed-roofed porch in the corner of the house, with tapered posts. Most windows on the rear wing (which may predate the main block) are 6/6.

The property also includes the site of a 19th century mill on Glade Run. Two historic photographs of the mill are included in this survey material. It was apparently frame, two-stories high, with a stone foundation, and built in two sections. The later section, perhaps early 20th century, has a concrete block foundation, and encloses the formerly-exposed mill wheel. The foundation is all that remains of the mill.














