DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is situated on a bank in a hilly area off White Church-Steyer Road approximately one mile south of Audley Wall-Man Road. The house faces northeast. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a two story two bay by one bay ell. A two story tower is located to the west end of the southwest elevation of the ell. A single story, shed roof one bay addition with a porch is located on the rear southwest elevation of the main structure. An entrance appears at this porch and another on the center facade (which has been boarded up).

An interior brick chimney is located towards the northwest elevation where the ell meets the main block. A second chimney appears on the opposite southeast elevation of the roof. One over one sash windows light the house. One over one windows appear in the gable ends of the main structure. The house rests on a stone foundation. The house is covered with asphalt shingles. Tar paper covers the roof.

A coal shed and a privy are also located on the property.
