The original Garrett County Jail and Sheriff's Office buildings which appear in the 1975 survey were demolished and replaced with two visually unsympathetic annexes on the north and south elevations of the Garrett County Courthouse (G-VI-A-001). The addition at the corner of Fourth and Alder Streets stands on the site of the original Jail and Sheriff's Office. Like the addition on the northwest side of the courthouse, this one is constructed of a yellow-brown brick laid in stretcher bond; the brick of both new additions is slightly darker in color than that of the original courthouse building. Each addition is also topped with a flat roof and pierced by several modern plate-glass windows with cement sills. Modern glass and metal doors provide access to the interior. Because of the placement of both of these annexes, the visually commanding siting and orientation of the original courthouse has been somewhat compromised, especially on the southeast and northwest elevations. The current building which stands on the site of the former Jail and Sheriff's Office is in very good condition.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Located at 204 South Fourth Street in Oakland, Garrett County, the buildings stand on the southwest corner at the intersection of Fourth and Alder Streets, immediately east of the Garrett County Courthouse.</p> <p>The Garrett County Jail and Sheriff's Office consists of two connected masonry structures:</p> <p>A. Sheriff's Office - Originally built as the Sheriff's residence, the house is a two and a half story brick structure with a stone foundation in the Queen Anne style. It has a steep pitch hip roof with asphalt shingles; a pointed dormer and one story frame porch along Alder Street, the north side; large windows; and a stone arch entranceway with columns along Fourth Street, the east side. Entrance to the living quarters was from the porch along Alder Street.</p> <p>B. Jail - The jail is a rectangular structure built of rusticated stone blocks and has a hip roof with a parapet encircling it. The sides are divided into bays with barred arch windows nearly the height of the building. The foundation walls have barred windows below the upper bays. The stone of this structure is described in the <u>Commissioners' Proceedings</u> (p. 205) as Number 1 Buff Bedford rock.</p> <p>While the interiors of both structures have been altered somewhat to meet the changing needs of the Sheriff's Department, the exteriors are basically unaltered.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The Garrett County Jail and Sheriff's Office, which originally included the Sheriff's residence, is a 1905 Queen Anne Brick structure with a castle-like stone cell block attached to the south side. It was built by the Brady Construction Company of Fairmont, West Virginia, and was designed by Holmboe and Lafferty, an architectural firm from Clarksburg, West Virginia. The total cost of construction listed in the <u>Commissioners' Proceedings</u> is \$35,981.00.</p>


