

Although the overall massing and fenestration on this building remain the same as in the 1975 survey, the house has undergone several minor changes. The top portion of the portico has been clad in aluminum siding at the first and second floor levels, and the undersides of the eaves have also been clad in aluminum siding. Finally, a one-story yellow brick addition with a small second-story flat-roofed frame addition directly above it has been appended to the rear of the main block; the walls of this brick addition have been laid in stretcher bond. The addition is topped with an asphalt-shingled roof. There are no visible outbuildings on the property. The building, which still houses the Durst Funeral Home, is currently occupied and remains in excellent condition.

<p>21 North Second Street in Oakland, Garrett County, stands on the east side of the street at the intersection of Center Street, southeast corner.</p> <p>The house is a turn-of-the-century Colonial Revival yellow brick structure, two and a half stories high, with a hip roof, large dormers, and a large front (west side) porch with two stories high Ionic columns. The symmetrical facade (west side) has three bays with a center doorway on each floor flanked by large double-hung wooden sash windows with one-over-one lights. Three large dormers pierce the roof on the front.</p> <p>The house is structurally sound. Although converted for commercial use as a funeral home, the exterior appears to be basically unaltered since construction.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>Located in the 1860s Pennington Addition to Oakland, this Colonial Revival house, preserved through an adaptive use, was probably built about 1900 when this style came into prominence in Western Maryland. Two other houses of this style that stand further north on Second Street appear to date from about 1910.</p>


