The Carlos and Phyllis Pacheco House is recommended not eligible for the National Register. Although helping to document settlement patterns in the Oakland area during the mid-twentieth century, the dwelling possesses poor integrity of materials, design, workmanship, feeling, and association. Research has not identified any significant associations with historic persons or events. The house neither reflects the distinctive characteristics of a particular architectural style nor embodies the representative work of a master craftsman or method of construction. The building also does not appear to potentially provide important information for the study of history.

The Carlos and Phyllis Pacheco House (G-VI-A-041) is located at 623 South Third Street in Oakland. The mid-twentieth-century one-and-one-half-story frame and brick Tudor Revival cottage is four bays wide and four bays deep. It has a cross-gable roof with multiple projecting front gables and a one-story gabled side wing on its northeast elevation. An offset brick projecting gable dominates the front elevation. Facing southeast, the dwelling sits on a flat rectangular lot in a subdivision of similar homes along Third Street. The sides of the lot are defined by rows of evergreen trees.

The dwelling is clad in vinyl siding and rests on a concrete block foundation that encloses a full cellar. The projecting front gabled wing is clad in red brick laid in running bond. The roof is sheathed in asphalt shingles and finished with a shallow box cornice covered with vinyl. There is a centered half-width shed-roofed wall dormer on the back (northwest) elevation. A shed-roofed enclosed back porch is appended to the western corner of the house. A shed-roofed frame sunroom is appended to the southwest elevation of this porch. An interior brick chimney is located between the main house and the side gabled wing.

The centrally-placed front entrance leads into the projecting front wing. It has a paneled wood door with a row of arched lights. Its hooded surround has been covered with vinyl siding. The back door was not visible inside the back porch. The singly-spaced and paired windows are one-over-one wooden double-hung sash. The dwelling's vinyl siding covers the door and window surrounds.

Appended to the rear (northwest) elevation of the back porch and sunroom is a one-story two-car garage/workshop. This L-plan frame building is clad in vinyl siding and rests on a concrete block foundation. Its cross-gable roof is sheathed in asphalt shingles and finished with a shallow box cornice covered with vinyl. In addition, the building has multi-pane fixed-sash wooden windows. A macadam drive leads from the street around the northeast side and rear of the house to the garage.

Constructed in 1942 according to Garrett County tax records, the Carlos and Phyllis Pacheco House relates to the establishment of residential areas on the outskirts of Oakland in the mid-twentieth century. Area landowners subdivided parcels along much of South Third Street, then part of the Garrett Highway (US 219's predecessor) and the principal road network leading south of town, during the 1940s. An example of settlement radiating outward from village and town centers along established road networks, development of the South Third Street area evolved during this period in response to Oakland's continuing role as the county's seat of government and the principal market town for southern Garrett County. Oakland annexed the South Third Street area into its corporate limits in 1989.


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

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Resource Sketch Map
