According to information prepared by SHA, Bridge 11004 does not meet the criteria for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places. Constructed in 1924, the steel girder bridge is similar to over 20 bridges on state roads and, it is assumed, to others still extant on the railroads of Maryland. This type of bridge was used extensively for railroad overpasses and is neither rare or unique. The bridge is located outside the Oakland Historic District and is not located in any other known district.
