<p>This brick L-shaped farmhouse faces west 4 bays by 2 with 2 bays in the wing running east along the south end wall. Two stories over a stone foundation open as land slopes away on the south-west, the roof/ridgeline runs north-south, with wide eaves, and corbel cornice with with returns. Windows, 6 lights on 6, have white stone lintels over and below openings.</p> <p>Two doors open onto the center of the one-story porch sheltering the west side of the house, while a two-story porch is on the south side of the wing.</p> <p>Chimneys rise inside each gable end wall from hearth fireplaces in the main house, from a cooking fireplace in the wing.</p>
