DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The small log house, now a wing of a larger frame house, faces west on Flintville Road, the ridgepole running north-south. Of two rooms with a central chimney, it has a door and a window on east and west walls, six panes over six. It is on a stout stone foundation.

In the larger new house, a ~~note on~~ ~~the~~ ~~riser~~ ~~bottom~~ of the circular stair seen from the cellarway, James Love, 1841, indicates that the builder, perhaps himself the owner, was identifying the date of construction. This part of the house is two bays by two, two stories high, with a slate roof. A third section, facing south also, contains the modern furnace and plumbing that make these two parts of the house very comfortable.

There is tangible evidence of a moderately successful farming operation - a small house, well-kept, in three ages of construction. The log section, it self perhaps of two periods of construction, is in good condition (as log houses go - in excellent condition) apparently. The 1841 section carries base board heating, and is well kept; the new section is completely modern.
